







# Section Overview – Olympic Village

- Olympic Village is located at campus of Technical University
- 5 accommodation blocks with 1,057 twin rooms (A, B, C, D, E)
  - Total of 1550 people accommodated
  - Organizing committee also at the Olympic Village
- \* The rest of students at the block "F"
- Suites consist of two twin rooms and shared bath, toilet and kitchen
- \* Two internet connections in each room free of charge
- Each block has 24/7 reception
- K All entrances to blocks are guarded
- Special room at for sick people at each block

### Major milestones

- Deadline for filling accommodation data into Information System EYOWF 2011 - 31st January 2011
- Final rooming list 3th February 2011
- Starting with decoration of the Olympic Village 9th February 2011
- Arrival of Chefs de Mission 11th February 2011
- \* Arrival of rest of delegation 12th February 2011
