Kateřina Nyčová:

The positive evaluation of the preparations was heard in Lisbon

At the end of November, the organisers of the 10th European Youth Olympic Winter Festival (EYOWF) 2011 in the Liberec Region presented the state of preparations at the 38th EOC General Assembly in Lisbon. One of the presenters was Kateřina Nyčová, the Executive Director of the EYOWF 2011 Organising Committee.

Apart from a presentation of the EYOWF 2011 project in front of the audience, the two-day meeting was filled with personal meetings with EOC representatives, members of National Olympic Committees, organisers of Festivals and other events.

What kind of information about EYOWF 2011 did you present to the delegates of the General Assembly?

In our official presentation for the meeting of all the participants we summarised the form of the Festival and outlined our plans for the near future. We also brought a special edition of the Festival's Newsletter designed directly for this event, in which we included the most important and most recent points regarding the 2011 Festival. We focused primarily, however, on personal meetings with the delegates of the General Assembly.

Were the members of the Assembly satisfied with your presentation?

I have to say that the reaction from the board and the delegates of the General Assembly was positive. Over the two days there were a number of presentations on the schedule, so everyone was

strictly limited in time. Despite this, I believe that even in the short time we were given, we managed to point out all the essential things. We have also shown the EYOWF 2011 presentation video for the first time, which shows the Liberec Region and sports on the programme of the Festival.

Which other organisers made their presentations?

Apart from us, there were also presentations from organisers of other upcoming sporting events – for example the Winter Olympic Games in Vancouver in 2010 and Summer Games in London 2012, as well as the Youth Summer Olympic Games 2010 in Singapore and the Winter Games in Innsbruck 2012. The candidate cities for the winter and summer European Youth Festivals in 2015 were announced. Of interest is the fact that one of the candidates for the summer Festival is Brno, which will have to face competition from the Georgian capital, Tbilisi.

What are the most important conclusions from Lisbon for the Organising Committee?

After the crucial inspection visit from the EOC Coordination Commission for EYOWF 2011, which took place in the beginning of November, this is another positive evaluation of our work. On an international scale, the Czech Republic is seen as a experienced organiser. Despite having made a mark with our presentation, we must not slacken in our efforts. In two months, we have the Games of the IV Olympic Days for Children and Youth of the Czech Republic (ODM) 2010, which will be a thorough rehearsal for EYOWF 2011. We will intensify the preparations for EYOWF 2011 in the spring and we are going to publish a Technical manual and the Guide for the Chefs de mission, which are two most important documents for the Festival.

C topic Festival 2011 with image spot

The EYOWF 2011 Organising Committee produced a three-minute television image spot, which presents the host, the Liberec Region, and the eight sport disciplines of the 2011 Festival. The main themes of the spot are playfulness, dice and teenage temperament.

The clip for EYOWF 2011 was made by FTJ Video, a company which also produced the video for the Liberec candidature for the FIS Nordic World Championships in 2009. The most difficult aspect was shooting the winter video in the spring and summer of this year - i.e. without snow. Tomáš Forejt, owner of FTJ Video, explains: *"Fortunately, we could make use of this year's EYOWF Festival in Polish Sczyrk, where we took most of the shots. Further material was provided by Czech Television, Tipsport Arena in Liberec or the figure skating club BK Variace from Liberec." Time-lapse shots are frequent motifs in the video which serve to demonstrate* the dynamics, activity and life in the Region. Two seconds of the original classic shot are replayed 10,000 times faster and are actually filmed the whole day.

The main themes are youths and dice, which gradually introduces the entire Liberec Region and presents eight sport disciplines. "We addressed a group of students directly from Liberec, who also appear in other promotional materials of the Festival. The dynamics of the clip are emphasised by the music, for which we had to symbolically cross the ocean. The recording company is set in Canada. It was a real challenge for us," adds Tomáš Forejt.

The image spot for EYOWF 2011 will be prepared in a shorter, 30-second version. The organisers showed the spot for the first time at the end of November at the EOC General Assembly in Lisbon, where it met with appreciation.

A new department is born

The EYOWF Team consists of 140 members so far. The Festival requires 500 of them. There is also a special new quarterly for volunteers issued at present. It provides information regarding what is happing around the Festival in 2011, details about the departments the volunteers will join and dates of meetings and training sessions.
