- Parade of nations: in English alphabetical order

## Flower giving ceremonies

## \* Flower giving ceremony

- At venues
- O After the finish / end of competition
- First 3 athletes
- No equipment allowed
- Programme
  - First announcement that in 5 minutes before start
  - Start of the Flower Giving Ceremony
  - Athletes are invited to the podium
  - Winning Fanfare





## Medal Ceremony

- 🌿 Medal ceremony
  - At the Olympic Village
  - Start at 7pm.
  - First 3 athletes
  - No equipment allowed according to protocols
- 🐕 Programme
  - Start with the EYOWF official song
  - Speaker announcements athletes from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup> place
    - Athletes are invited to the podium
  - Officials congratulation
  - Flags and national anthem
  - End of the ceremony

  - Olympic flame
  - Stage for medal ceremony (visualization)
- 🐮 Deadlines
- \* New requirements from Olympic Committee
- Medal duplicity
