IBU License:	All athletes must have a valid IBU license.
Equipment:	according to IBU rules
Advertising:	According to EYOF Charter, Rule 15a. No form of advertising or publicity may appear in any form whatsoever on clothing, accessories or, more generally, on any item of clothing or piece of equipment worn or carried by the delegations du- ring the EYOWF, with the exception of the manu- facturer's identification and logo, as stipulated in the rules of the IOC. All violations of the provisions of this clause shall lead to disqualification and the withdrawal of the accreditation of the person con- cerned.
Accreditation:	via NOC according to general information – see www.eyowf2011.cz
Accommodation:	via NOC according to general information – see www.eyowf2011.cz
Transportation:	Organizer will provide shuttle bus service from the Olympic Village to the venue. Teams with their own cars should register these in advance during the accreditation process. After arrival teams will rece- ive parking permissions for their car. Without this permission you will be not able to go to the venue with your car!
Competition Office:	In the Olympic Village, every day 8:00 – 20:00 At the biathlon stadium "Brizky" during official trai- nings and competitions.
Team Captains' meetings:	according to official programme (see below) in the Olympic Village
Bibs:	will be issued in the Race Office at the venue one hour before zeroing



Medical service:	Organiser will provide emergency medical service during trainings and competitions.
Insurance:	 All athletes, officials and members of the National Olympic Committees who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Organising Committee will arrange following insurance: Third party liability (personal injuries and damages). Basic medical costs and individual accidents (permanent disability, consequential damage). All NOCs are nevertheless strongly advised to provide for an adequate insurance (travel insurance) policy for all members of their delegations. The OC accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury, or for property loss or damage incurred by Competitors and Officials.
Ceremonies:	After each competition there will be a flower cere- mony at the venue (best 3 athletes/teams). Medal ceremony (best 3 athletes/teams) will be organised in the Olympic Village – see general programme at www.eyowf2011.cz. Organiser can change the pro- gramme according to current weather conditions.
Other Information:	Starting order of mixed relay will be based on re- sults from the last EYOWF in Szczyrk 2009.
Arms and Ammunition Import:	The participants of EYOWF 2011 who are citizens of EU member countries and who have a European gun license in which the rifles are registered, have to present their European gun license and organi- zer's official invitation for the event when crossing the border of the Czech Republic. Participants out- side the EU have to present a Firearm accompany- ing letter, which is to be arranged with the Embassy



of the Czech Republic in their home country, see below and www.mzv.cz. The import permission must be confirmed at the Embassy or Consulate of the Czech Republic. The import of rifles and ammunitions is free of charge on the basis of the following documents: Invitation letter and Competition Invitation. When crossing the border, individual teams are asked to present the Official Invitation **Rifle Transport During** The transport of the rifles from the place of acco-Event: mmodation to the stadium and back has to be carried out with an open breech-block. Arms and the respective ammunition must be stored separately. The maximum number of rifles in the room in the OLV is two which must be stored securely in cases. The room must be locked when left empty. The ammunition will be stored in the biathlon venue Brizky in the ammunition depot in conformity with the legislation of the Czech Republic. The person responsible for the National Team is obliged to follow the above mentioned regulations. Storage / waxing: There will be storage/waxing team cabins available for participating NOC teams in Biathlon venue Jab-
